2. SESAME GRADING PARAMETERS

2.1 GENERAL REQUIREMENTS

Sesame Seeds shall have a good natural color, free of objectionable odor, contains no weevil and other live insect causing damage, free from visible mould free from glass and metal fragments, free from toxic seeds and have a maximum moisture content of 10.0% by weight.

2.2 DEFINITIONS

Moisture Content	The moisture content, expressed on a wet weight bases, shall be determined using an approved moisture meter.
Foreign matter	Anything other than sound Sesame Seeds, this will pass through a 1.0 mm round sieve hole and sorted matter on the purity work board. It includes all organic and inorganic matters like any mineral, animal or plant matter, Leaves, pods, twigs,



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	earth, sand, dust, stones, other crops seeds, detached seed coats and the likes.
DSW	Anything other than sound Sesame Seeds, which will pass through a 1.0 mm round hole sieve and sorted matter on the purity work board. These are seeds affected by natural or man made factor as a whole and piece of sesame seed which are distinctly: Heat damage, Germ damage, Mold damage, Weevil led (Insect damage), Sprouted, Split, Immature, Shriveled, Broken kernel and Other damage
Weevil and live insect causing damage	Weevils, live insect and pests that affect and cause damage on sesame seed
Good Natural Color	The natural appearance of the grain, which is pure and has not been affected by natural or man-made factors
Objectionable Odor	Unpleasant smell that is caused by weathering, chemical contamination, mould infection, disease or damage caused by insect.
Contrasting Colour	Sesame seed which differs in colour from the predominant class.

The lower of two grading parameters will determine the final grade of Sesame Seed.



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SUBSTANDARD

Sesame seed shall be deemed to comply with this standard if upon inspection and grading the provision in the above clauses are satisfied. Sesame seed which does not meet the requirements of the above clauses is considered as substandard and the owner shall treat the product to comply with the above requirements.

PACKAGING	
Packaging	Each grade of Sesame shall be packed in clean and sound 50 Kg or 100 kg capacity polypropylene (PP) bags used no more than once prior to deposit. Delivery will be effective on Net Weight basis, which implies that weighing of Sesame will be done on exclusive of bags basis and no additional payment will be given for the cost of bag.
SAMPLING PROCEDURES	
Sampling and analysis at time of deposit and delivery	Conduct sampling and grading analysis using ECX standards
Sampling procedure	Sampling procedure based on ECX standards
Failing of sample	Owner of the commodity has the right to request an appeal of the sample and/or grade to the branch head for the first failure and the branch head shall communicate the ECX Quality Unit for proper direction and settlement
Dispute settlement	If agreement is not reached on primary claim third party appeal shall be proceeded to QSAE as per the appeal procedure

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Penalty on warehoused goods after expiration	expire on the execution of the trade A penalty of 3.5% per day calculated on the tradable value using the closing price of the same grade as the warehoused goods will be applied after the expiry of warehouse receipts. However, if the last date of the warehouse receipts expiry fall on Saturday, Sunday or a Public Holiday, the Exchange shall exempt the depositor from penalty for such date.
Contract quote basis	All prices will be quoted "Ex- Warehouse", exclusive of taxes, fees and charges.

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5. STANDARD DELIVERY TERMS
